## IRRIGATION SPECIALIST

#### **SUMMARY:**

The Irrigation Specialist works in collaboration with the District grounds crew, maintenance personnel and serves as the District's point of contact in the area of irrigation technology. The Irrigation Specialist troubleshoots irrigation problems; repairs existing systems; designs and installs new systems; works from plans and prints and documents system changes. Persons in this position are responsible for all equipment and repairs, from the irrigation connection to the potable water supply protection device (backflow preventer). The Irrigation Specialist coordinates watering schedules with sports activities, special events and periods of rain.

#### **DEGREE OF SUPERVISION:**

The Irrigation Specialist is responsible for the irrigation needs of the district and may provide leadership to other district employees assisting in irrigation projects. The Irrigation Specialist primarily works independently or with minimum supervision on all district irrigation needs.

The Irrigation Specialist is under the day to day supervision of the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor and under general supervision of the Director of Maintenance and Operations. Evaluations will be performed by the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor on a timeline in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement.

### **DUTIES AND TASKS:**

### (All duties and tasks are essential unless noted as secondary with an S)

- 1. Maintain the irrigation systems for all school sites and district facilities in a safe, good working condition.
  - A. Troubleshoots irrigation problems;
  - B. Repairs existing systems;
  - C. Designs and installs new sprinkler systems;
  - D. Works from plans and prints and documents system changes;
  - E. Determines proper pipe and valve sizing;
  - F. Performs low-voltage wiring for valves and controllers;
  - G. Rebuilds valves and sprinklers;
  - H. Coordinates watering schedules with sports activities, special events and periods of rain;
  - I. Responds to after-hours reports of water related emergencies (S);
  - J. Inspect irrigation equipment for proper adjustment, damage, needed repairs, and safety issues;
  - K. Assist skilled grounds crew or maintenance personnel in work projects by performing semi-skilled labor (S);
- 2. Maintain records, prepare reports and order supplies
  - A. Inventory irrigation equipment and supplies and purchase as needed (in

- B. Update site plans and drawings to reflect changes;
- C. Estimate the quantity and types of materials or supplies needed for a work project;
- D. Determine the most cost-effective means of for projects
- E. Maintain Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) so they are accessible and up to date;
- 3. Operate equipment or drive a vehicle to secure parts or deliver materials.
  - A. Operate and provide routine maintenance of small truck used in scope of work; (S)
  - B. Operates tractors, backhoes, and other equipment related to the repair and installation of the district irrigation needs.
