General Description:

Serve as a lead ground maintenance worker performing a variety of activities in the maintenance and repair of grounds area(s) and athletic fields; apply required pesticides; direct grounds keeping personnel as assigned; ensure availability of required equipment; protect against erosion; prepare and maintain grounds for assemblies, recreational activities and/or athletic events; ensure assignments are completed in a safe, proper and timely manner; train and provide work direction, and guidance to assigned staff.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Oversee and participate in grounds maintenance and gardening activities in the beautification of organization-wide grounds and landscaped areas; lead, train and provide work direction and guidance to assigned personnel.
- Mow, edge, trim, and water lawns, fields, and other turf grounds; prepare and fertilize soil; water various grounds areas by hand or by operating the irrigation system.
- Maintain grounds maintenance equipment in safe operating condition; perform minor maintenance on equipment such as changing blades, greasing and changing oil.
- Perform general grounds cleanup, including picking up paper, trash, and debris on grounds areas, parking lots, playgrounds, athletic fields, and other assigned areas; empty waste receptacles.
- Lead and participate in planting, cultivating, pruning, spraying, fertilizing, and irrigating flowers, trees, grass, and shrubs; hoe and pull weeds and rake leaves; edge walkways; sweep litter from walks and driveways.
- Prepare grounds and athletic fields for assemblies, recreational activities, and/or athletic events.
- Procure materials, supplies, and equipment; order materials, maintain inventory, and ensure availability of items needed to complete tasks.
- Coordinate grounds maintenance activities to meet organization-wide needs; inspect completed work at school sites and locations to assure accuracy, completeness and compliance with

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established guidelines and procedures; coordinate response to work orders and administrative requests.

- Confer with Supervisor and site administrators regarding irrigation schedules, spraying schedules, and field preparation.
- Operate heavy equipment including trucks, tractors, mowers, and a backhoe.
- Maintain grounds maintenance equipment in safe operating condition; perform minor maintenance on equipment such as changing blades, greasing and changing oil.
- Repair irrigation systems and components.
- Communicate with personnel, administrators and various outside agencies to exchange information, coordinate activities and resolve issues or concerns.
- Prepare and maintain a variety of records and reports related to work orders, inspections, irrigation systems, pesticide applications, purchase orders and assigned duties.
- Perform end of the day review of projects and assignments; submit ground maintenance related information and project status reports to the Supervisor as requested.
- Operate a computer and assigned software; drive a vehicle to conduct work.
- Perform other duties as required, related to the primary job duties of the assigned position.

Required Qualifications:

Knowledge of:

- Grounds maintenance procedures including mowing, edging, raking and weeding.
- Methods, equipment and materials used in gardening and grounds maintenance work.
- Cultivating, fertilizing, watering and spraying of flowers, trees and shrubs.
- Procedures, methods, materials and equipment utilized in the general installation, repair and maintenance of irrigation systems.
- Operation of hand and power tools and equipment used in ground maintenance.
- Principles of training and providing work direction.
- Basic inventory methods and practices.
- Oral and written communication skills.
- Interpersonal skills using tact, patience and courtesy.
- Methods and materials used in controlling weeds and other pests.
- Record-keeping and basic report preparation techniques.
- Health and safety regulations.
- Basic math.
- Safe use of herbicides, insecticides, fertilizers, and plant foods to maintain the growth of grasses, trees, shrubs, and flowers.
- District policies and practice for requisitioning materials.

Ability to:

- Oversee and participate in grounds maintenance and gardening activities in the beautification of organization-wide grounds and landscaped areas.
- Train and provide work direction and guidance to assigned personnel.
- Coordinate grounds maintenance activities to meet organization-wide needs.
- Mow, edge, water, weed, fertilize, rake and cultivate lawns, flower beds, athletic fields and other landscaped areas.

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- Assure athletic fields and grounds areas are maintained in a clean, orderly and safe condition.
- Operate and maintain hand and power tools and other equipment used in grounds maintenance.
- Apply specialized chemicals to control and eradicate weeds, gophers and other pests.
- Maintain records and prepare reports.
- Observe health and safety regulations.
- Operate a computer and assigned software.
- Meet schedules and timelines.
- Assign employee duties and inspect completed work for accuracy.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Follow written and oral instructions.
- Make basic arithmetical calculations.
- Accurately estimate material and labor costs.
- Demonstrate leadership and sound judgment in decision making.
- Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with others.
- Work independently and follow through on assignments with minimal direction and supervision.

Education: High school graduation or the equivalent GED.

Experience: Three (3) years of increasingly responsible grounds maintenance experience. Some experience in a supervisory or lead capacity.
